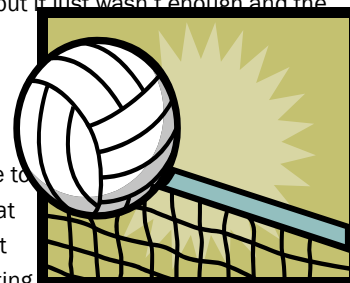
8th Grade
