To qualify for the \$1,000 Parishioner Tuition Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

1. Parish Registration

Families must be formally registered as a member of Transfiguration. Forms are available from the School or Parish Office. If you have questions regarding parish registration, or you want to verify if your family is registered, please contact Mr. Andy Jacobson 651-501-2216 principal@transfigurationmn.org

2. Mass Attendance

Mass attendance at Transfiguration is important for several reasons, with the most important being building community through Sunday worship and formation in Jesus Christ. It is vitally important as Catholics to build roots in community of Catholic faith and connect with the Pastor and parishioners in Mass. Families must attend Mass at least three times per month at Transfiguration.

3. Participate in Financial Stewardship

Each family must submit a Stewardship Pledge Form each year, and actively and regularly participate in financial stewardship at Transfiguration Catholic Church. Regular participation is determined by a review of contributions for the twelve months preceding a completed academic registration. New families in the school will qualify for the parish scholarship in their first year if they register in the parish and complete a financial stewardship form. Mass Attendance Requirement Logistics

Mass attendance will be recorded and reported three times per academic year (Sept 1-Nov 30; Dec 1-Feb 28; Feb 29-May 31). Dates on which the family attended Mass at Transfiguration should be circled. Forms are to be delivered to the student's homeroom teacher on the reporting date indicated, who in turn will deliver them to the school office for review by Father Erickson and Mr. Jacobson.

According to one's own payment arrangements, credits will be applied to tuition bills based on the *last* reporting period. Questions regarding billing and the application of the parish scholarship to invoices may be directed to Mr. Andy Jacobson.

If you are unable to satisfy the Mass attendance requirement for a legitimate reason, please indicate so in the space provided next to the pertinent dates. Father Erickson and Mr. Jacobson will review these notes and contact any families from whom more information is required.
